While at Dalhousie University in Halifax, Nova Scotia, he founded one of the first academic makerspaces in the country. He is currently involved with a Silicon Valley company developing a new type of 3D model search engine, which was recently featured in Discover Magazine.



**François Lahey** has run Voxel Factory, one of the first personal 3D printing stores in Canada, since April 2012. Voxel Factory's mission is to make 3D printing available and affordable to all Canadians. Over the last 2 years, he helped build more than 100 RepRap printers, maintained and fixed various models of 3D printers, and used the latest in 3D printing software.
