

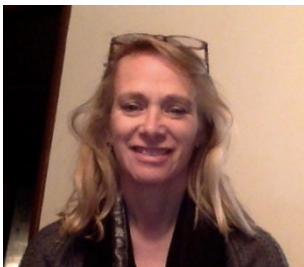

Research Data Management: Charting a New Course for Libraries in the 21st Century

Kathleen Shearer holds several positions at the national and international level. She is a Research Associate with the Canadian Association of Research Libraries (CARL) and is coordinating a project to develop a national library-based network for managing research data called Portage.

She is a Partnership Consultant with the Association of Research Libraries (ARL), and she is the part-time Executive Director of the Confederation of Open Access Repositories (COAR), an international association promoting the development of a global open access repository network.

She is a member of numerous groups, including co-chair of the Research Data Alliance Long Tail of Research Data Interest Group and Libraries for Research Data Interest Group. She is also chair of the Open Access Licenses and Agreements Task Force.
